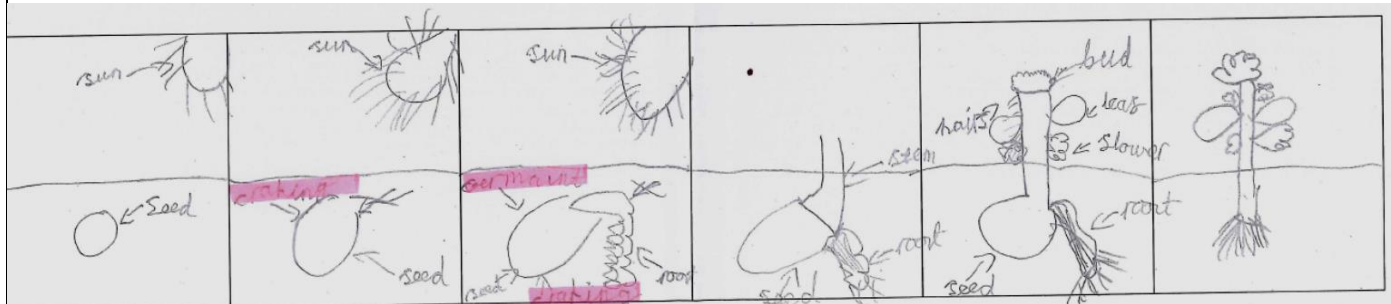
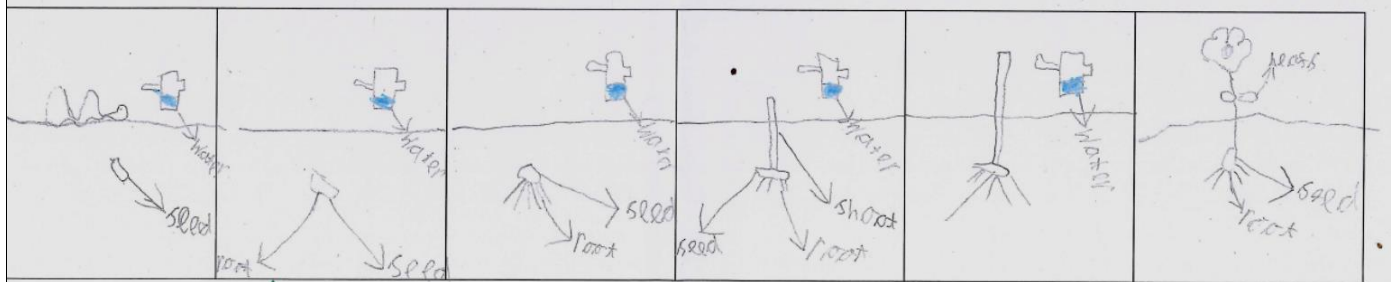


Topic: Plants	Year 2 Age 6-7	Title: Plant growth comic strip
Working Scientifically		Conceptual Knowledge Focus observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants

Example

After observing plant growth over time, children were asked to draw and order the life cycle of a plant, using scientific vocabulary to describe the events.



The teacher has 'tickled pick' the child's labels – 'cracking' and 'germinate'.

Children meeting the objective would be able to use information they had gained from observing plant growth over time to sequence and describe plant growth. Application of observations would be noticeable when, for example, children draw roots growing.
