Working Scientifically Focus Do: observe closely		Conceptual Knowledge Focus observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants

Example

Children were asked to draw the cress seeds before and after they had grown.



Children meeting the objective would be able to observe closely, noticing the differences between plants.

The teacher asked each of these children to look again to further improve their observation e.g. *Does cress have leaves on its stem? What colour are the cress stems? What colour are the cress leaves?*
