<p><b>Working Scientifically Focus</b> <b>Review:</b> reporting on findings from enquiries, using results to draw simple conclusions</p>		<p><b>Conceptual Knowledge Context</b> Function of teeth – to find out about what damages teeth and how to look after them.</p>
