



<p>Topic: Plants</p>	<p>Year 3 Age 7-8</p>	<p>Title: Plant labelling and question raising</p>
<p>Working Scientifically Focus Plan: raise their own questions about what they notice</p>		<p>Conceptual Knowledge Focus identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers</p>
<p>Example</p> <p>Labelling of a real plant collected on a weedy walk:</p>  <p>Then asking their own questions about plants:</p>  <p>Children meeting the objective would be able to label the parts of the plant and describe the function of each part. A next step for the children is to support them to identify and construct questions which can be investigated.</p>
