



PSTT/TTS Schools' Photography Competition

Competition Details

The Primary Science Teaching Trust, in partnership with TTS, invites schools to submit entries for our photography competition.

We would like **children** to take photos to represent '**Science at our school**' and add a caption to the image.

Schools may organise their own internal competition (for which we can provide downloadable certificates for schools to print and present). Only one entry may be submitted on behalf of each school.

PSTT Fellows' schools may enter the competition, which is open to **all primary schools in UK (children aged 4-11 years)**.

Photographs and captions must be uploaded via the PSTT website.

There will be only one overall competition winner, receiving around £350 worth of TTS resources for the school. The winner will be decided by a panel of judges selected by the PSTT.

There will be 5 Runner Up prizes, each being a multi-pack of PSTT resources.

20 further additional 'merit' prizes of PSTT resources will be provided.

PSTT will display winning entries along with some additional entries in our PSEC Photo Gallery. Schools will be notified if their entry is selected for display. A discount code for PSEC will be offered to schools with an image displayed in the gallery.

The closing date for the competition is 14th December 2018.

Terms and Conditions

The submitting school is responsible for agreeing to the terms and conditions on behalf of the creator of the photograph.

All photographs must be taken at the submitting primary school.

Only one entry per school may be submitted. All submissions must be uploaded via the PSTT website in order to be considered. PSTT cannot accept any responsibility for uploading failures.

Entries must be received by midnight on 14th December 2018. Winners will be notified no later than 1st March 2018.

Submitted photographs must be original, created and/or taken by a pupil of the school who is between the ages of 4 and 11 years old. Photographs must not contain any materials owned or controlled by a third party for which you have not obtained a licence. The photograph must not infringe the copyright, trademark, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity.

PSTT respects photographers' copyrights and copyrights shall remain vested with the creator of the image. Upon making the submission, you grant PSTT worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty free, sub-licensable right and licence to use, publish, reproduce, display, adapt, create derivative works, distribute, have distributed, print, in whole or in part, in any form, in all media forms now or hereafter known, to promote the contest, image, the photographer or for any editorial, marketing or educative use.

PSTT and TTS Group reserve the right to publish the winning schools' details on their website, and in all media forms.

PSTT will appoint judges for the contest. The judging panel shall assess and determine the winning photos. The decision of PSTT's judging panel will be final and binding on all participants in respect to all matters relating to the contest.

If there are people in the photograph, the school must have obtained written permission from each person in that photograph (and if under age 18, this is signed by the parent or guardian) and must be able to provide copies of these permissions if requested. The school will sign a disclaimer on submission of entry to this effect. These permission forms will be required to be submitted if the entry is judged to be the competition winner, a runner up or merit awardee and/or if a photograph is selected to be displayed in the gallery at PSEC.
