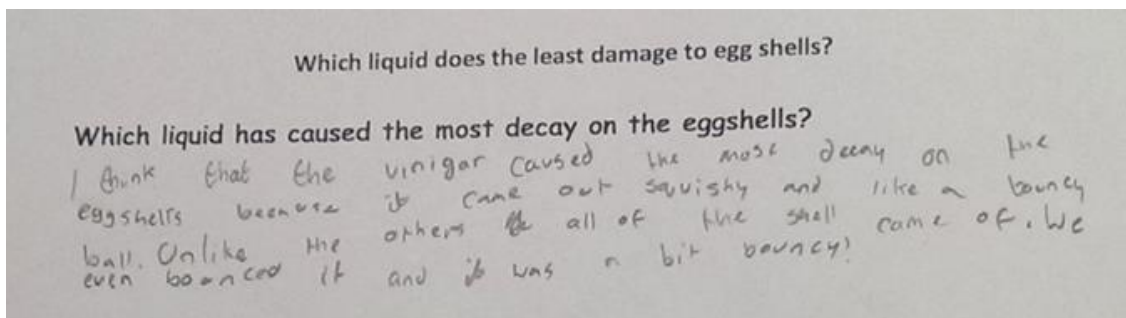
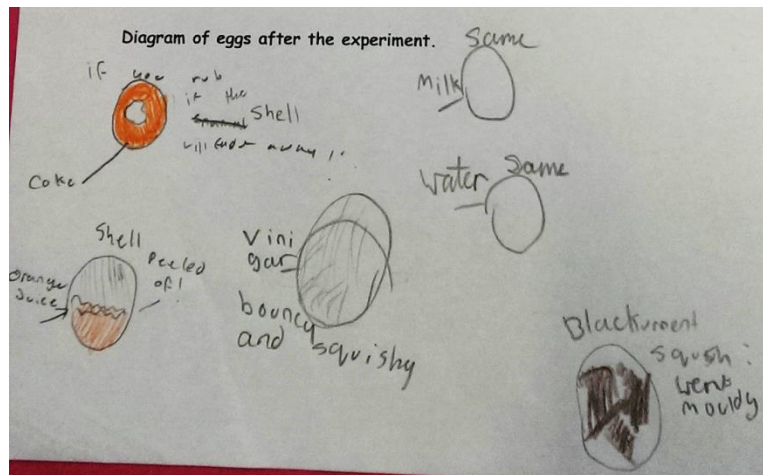
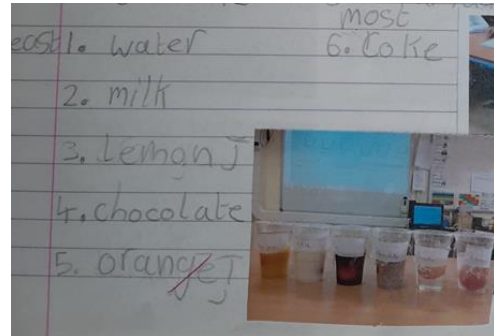


<b>Topic:</b> Animals including humans	<b>Year 4</b> Age 8-9	<b>Title:</b> Teeth (eggs) in liquids
<b>Working Scientifically Focus Review:</b> Use results to draw simple conclusions		<b>Conceptual Knowledge Context</b> Function of teeth – to find out about what damages teeth and how to look after them

**Example**

Children were asked to draw conclusions about a class investigation which considered the effect on hard boiled eggs (representing teeth) of soaking for one week in different liquids.



Children meeting the objective would be able to compare the effect of different liquids, for example, by ordering from most to least damage, by drawing or by describing.
