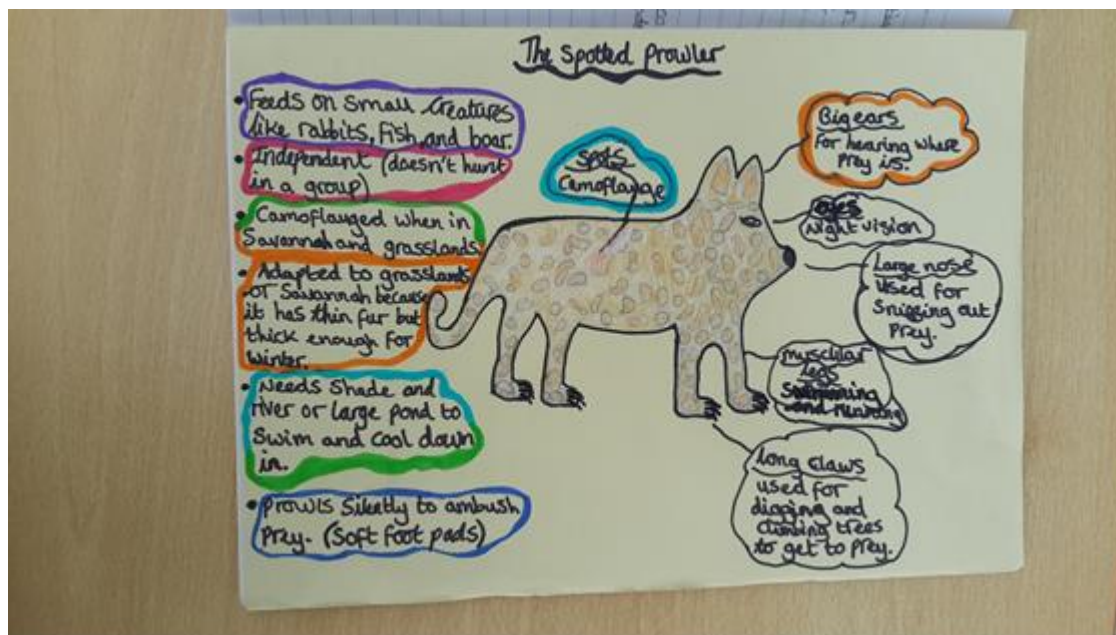
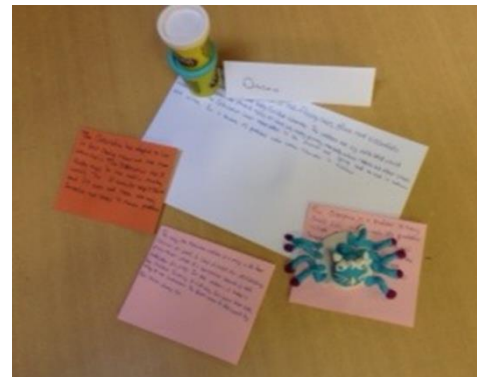


Topic: Evolution	Year 6 Age 10-11	Title: Create own adapted animal
Working Scientifically Link report and present		Conceptual Knowledge Focus identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways

Example

Children were asked to invent their own animal or plant and explain how they are adapted to live in a particular environment. They could model their animal in play dough or draw their animal and label its adaptations.



Children meeting the objective would be able to create an animal and explain, with reference to specific features/characteristics, how it is adapted to survive in its habitat. Some children may consider its predators or prey.
