I work in the Biologics Engineering Department in AstraZeneca. I work in the Oncology Department where we develop cancer medicines to help to improve patients' lives.


What did I like doing when I was at school?

What do I do as a protein biochemist?




I study proteins. I use human or mouse cells to make human proteins. We use these proteins to separate out particular blood proteins (antibodies) from our antibody libraries, which we think could eventually become an antibody drug for a disease.

How does what I do make the world a better place?

My research helps to discover life changing medicines and helps millions of patients around the world.

What I like about my job

I love solving problems in science. It is very exciting when you face a challenge and you can come up with a solution. I can design substances that one day may become a medicine.

I grew up in a country where the resources were limited for doing innovative, cutting-edge science. So I worked hard to achieve a bursary to study abroad where I found amazing opportunities to interact with many clever scientists and to access the best equipment.

If you want to be a protein biochemist, you need:


- * to be interested in DNA and proteins
