The Thinking Doing Talking Science course **empowers teachers to:**

- create opportunities for higher order thinking
- craft inclusive, yet challenging, science lessons.

It is suitable for all teachers in key stage 1 and key stage 2 and is compatible with any curriculum or scheme of work.

The Primary Science Teaching Trust's (PSTT's) new two-day course consists of two in-person training days a term apart, with an online catch-up session in between. As well as experiencing practicals on the 2-day course, teachers will also have access to additional materials from previous courses. Thinking, Doing, Talking Science strategies will be exemplified through a wide range of science topics from both primary key stages.
